



WAIKANA'E GOLF CLUB JUNIOR PROGRAMME 2013

CRITERIA FOR PROMOTION FROM JR9 TO JR18

Stamina

- ✓ Can walk 18 holes managing own golf clubs, carrying clubs or using a trundler

Dress

- ✓ Appropriate, tidy golf dress and shoes

Organisation

- ✓ Accesses & marks/signs own card; keeps accurate scores
- ✓ Carries sufficient tees, markers, balls, pencils, pitch mark repairer

Play

- ✓ Consistently scores around 50 or below on nine holes using Red Tees

Play on the Course and Green

- ✓ Takes care of the course, replacing divots, raking bunkers leaving rakes outside of bunkers
- ✓ Takes care on the green and around hole, handling flagstick; repairs pitch marks on green
- ✓ Marks ball, correct order of play, attends flag as needed

Basic understanding of rules

- ✓ On tee, order of play, out of bounds, playing a provisional ball, hazard and bunker play

Etiquette & Respect on the Course

- ✓ Demonstrates respect for all other players, standing still and keeping silent when another is playing
- ✓ Comments to other players are always encouraging
- ✓ Demonstrates respect for the course, replacing divots

Junior Golfer Behaviour

- ✓ Demonstrates respect for the Club, all other members, juniors and adults, the club surrounds, and equipment
- ✓ Is polite and co-operative at coaching sessions, junior competitions, inter-club competitions and in the club house.

ASSESSMENT & GRADUATION PROCESS

- ✓ Junior Golfer/Parent notifies Marcia Guest that the Junior would like to be assessed for promotion to JR18
- ✓ Marcia requests member of Junior Committee or Junior Coach to carry out assessment, accompanying Junior for 18 holes
- ✓ If Junior does not meet all of the criteria, he/she is given constructive feedback to work on particular criteria and to request another assessment after a few weeks. This info is reported to Marcia.
- ✓ If Junior meets the above criteria, parents are contacted to seek their approval (increase in Golf Fees for JR18)
- ✓ Marcia/Carolyn and Club are notified.
- ✓ Junior is congratulated by Junior Convenor, David Bayvel, at junior gathering and graduates from JR9 – JR18 at WGC receiving acknowledgement with a WGC Junior certificate.
