

## **COURSE REPORT**

### **WEATHER**

- There has been 209mm of rain recorded for this month 70mm of that was in one day.

### **GREENS**

- They have been sprayed with a fungicide, and a liquid fertiliser

### **COMPLETED WORK**

- Pot holes on the drive way and around the course were repaired after heavy rain washed some aggregate away.
- After Treescape were finished stump grinding, the wood chips were removed then these areas were renovated.
- Goodmans finished the bridge by the 3<sup>rd</sup> tees.
- A pole pruner was hired and the Phoenix Palms on the 14<sup>th</sup> were pruned.

### **COURSE GROOM**

- Fairways were cut twice a week.
- Tees were cut weekly and tee pads were trimmed around.
- Surrounds were cut weekly with the fairway mower.
- Rough was cut every week.
- The bunkers were raked every Monday and Friday.
- The greens were cut six days a week and rolled once a week.
- Hazard lines have been cut twice this month.
- The bunkers were edged with a weed eater and fly mowed.
- New holes on greens were cut Tuesdays and Fridays.
- Rubbish bins were emptied every Monday and Friday.
- Weed eating around the 90, 135 and 180 fairway markers was carried out once a month.
- The junior red tees are mowed twice a month.

## **MACHINERY**

- All mowers and tractors are serviced monthly.
- The irrigation pump was sent away to be refurbished.
- The Fairway and the greens mower cutting units have been sent away to have new base plates fitted and the reel grinded.
- The Ford Work Ute has got a new W.O.F and has had the Fuel sender replaced.

- No safety issues this month.

- Weed spray around trees and paths.
- Clean up along the stream in front of the Club House.
- Install irrigation pump back.
- Aerate the greens with needle tines.
