

COURSE REPORT **October 20th-November-20th 2016**

WEATHER

- There has been 216mm of rain recorded for the month with a king moon, earth quakes and strong winds.

COMPLETED WORK

- On one of the wet days the smoko room, toilet and shower were scrubbed and sanitized of all mold and dirt.
- A drain that runs in to the 11th pond was dug out wider and deeper to take a bigger volume of water.
- A control valve has been replaced on the 12th green after the original was found to be leaking.

COURSE GROOM

- Fairways were cut once a week.
- Tees were cut weekly and tee pads were trimmed around.
- Surrounds were cut weekly with the fairway mower.
- Rough was cut three times this month.
- The bunkers were raked every Friday.
- The greens were cut six days a week and rolled twice a week.
- Hazard lines have been cut once this month.
- The bunkers were edged with a weed eater and fly mowed.
- New holes on greens were cut Fridays.
- Rubbish bins were emptied every Monday and Friday.
- Weed eating around the 90, 135 and 180 fairway markers was carried out once a month.
- The junior red tees are mowed weekly.

GREENS

- They have been sprayed with wetting agent, pesticide, fungicide and fertiliser.

MACHINERY

- The 4000-D Toro rough mower has had a full service which includes water and antifreeze, hydraulic oil and filters, engine oil and filters and transaxle oil replaced and all fuel and air filters replaced.
- The two Toro 2050-D greens mowers had the engine oil and filter changed and a full grease.
- The Toro 5510-D fairway mower had all the front roller bearings replaced on all of its cutting units it also had its engine oil and filter changed with a full grease.
- The Toro sidewinder had the engine oil and filter change with a full grease.
- The Ford courier Work Ute had two front tyres replaced and a wheel alignment.
- The Toro 2050-D greens mower cutting units were sent away to have new base plates fitted and the reel grinded.
