RULES FOR VICE-PRESIDENT'S AND VICE CAPTAIN'S TROPHIES

Competition: Vice-President's and Vice Captain's Trophies.

Eligibility: All male members who have an official NZGA 18 hole handicap.

Format: 18 holes of net strokeplay followed by 18 hole knockout matchplay on handicap. The lowest net 8 players will form a draw to play elimination matches over 18 holes, until a winner is found for the Vice-Presidents Trophy. The next 8 players names will form a draw for the Vice-Captain's Trophy. In the event of tied qualifying scores, positions in the draw will be decided by Countback. The draw format will be that published by NZGolf as the automatic draw.

All matches will commence at the first hole and be played on the dates set down by the Match Committee except by agreement by the players and with the concurrence of the Match Committee.

Matches will be over 18 holes taking handicap strokes as on the Scorecard. In the event of a match being "all square" after 18 holes, play will continue from the 1st hole played with stroke allocation as for the first 18 holes, until a player wins a hole. No other method of deciding a tie is acceptable and breaches will result in disqualification of both players.

The winner of each section will receive the appropriate Trophy and a prize. The runner-up of each section will receive a prize.

Tees: Blue

Entry: Name to be entered on a list at the shop and the entry fee of \$5.00 per player paid before commencing play in the qualifying round. Players must tee off before 10.00am on the date stipulated in the program or as varied by the Match Committee. Tee times may be booked on line or through the Shop. "Vice-Pres/Vice-Capt Qualifying" to be noted in the event block on the scorecard.

Disputes: if any, in the qualifying round, are to be referred as soon as possible and in any event before results are announced, to the Match Committee whose decision will be final.

Disputes arising in matchplay are to be decided as per Rule 2 of the Rules of Golf.

Note: Matchplay dates are listed in the programme.
