RULES FOR MIXED HANDICAP STROKE CUP

Competition: **Mixed Handicap Stroke Cup**

Eligibility: All members with an official NZGA 18 hole handicap who are financial at the date of play.

Format: Teams of two players, one male and one female, each play their own ball for 18 holes of net strokeplay (that is, total number of strokes played, less handicap). The two nett scores are summed for the team total. The winning team will be that with the lowest nett total. Mens maximum course handicap will be as per Blue chart and womens maximum = 40.4

In the event of two or more teams having the same nett score, they will share the trophy and any associated prizes will be allocated after a countback involving both cards of each tied team, that is, a combined countback.

Prizegiving will be in the Club Rooms as soon as possible on the day of the event.

Tees: Men: Blue Course;

Women: Yellow Course.

Entry: Players are to choose their own partners. Both players' names to be entered on the start sheet and the entry fee of \$5 per player paid before commencing play.

- Each partner must complete an Autoscore card which must be certified by a marker other than the partner.
- Both partners names are to be shown on both scorecards
- "Mixed Handicap Stroke Cup" must be shown in the event block on the card

Disputes: (if any) must be reported to, and will be dealt with under the Rules of Golf by the Match Committee at the end of play.
